### **Instructions for submitting an application:**

Application packages may be submitted electronically except for sealed official copy of the current transcript. The application package consists of the following documents:

- Completed scholarship application form;
- Essay articulating why the applicant should be considered for the scholarship and how quality relates to their chosen profession or major;
  - a maximum of two (2) typed or printed pages
- Letter of recommendation from 1 faculty member;
- Current photo;
- Sealed official copy of the applicant's current transcript.

### **Scholarship selection criteria includes:**

- Must be a Section 1203 member in good standing for at least 5 continuous years or family member (spouse, child or parent) of a Section 1203 member in good standing for at least 5 continuous years. If the member is a Section Board member or a member of the MNASQ Leadership Team the Section Board must approve the applicant.
- Must be enrolled in a program leading to an Associate, or Bachelors degree in Engineering, Technology, Physical or Natural Sciences, Mathematics, Statistics, Business Administration, Health Sciences, or Education at a recognized college or university.
- Must have a GPA of 3.0 or greater on a scale of 0-4.
- At the time of the award the applicant must have completed one academic year and be a full time student during award use.
- Essay must be submitted and selected by the Scholarship Committee. The decision of the committee is final.
